PROCLAMATION NO.

10GRANTING AMNESTY TO ALL FILIPINOS WHO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED, 11IMPRISONED, CHARGED AND/OR CONVICTED FOR ACTS OR OMISSIONS 12PUNISHABLE UNDER THE REVISED PENAL CODE OR SPECIAL LAWS IN 13CONNECTION WITH THE REBELLION WAGED BY THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF THE 14PHILIPPINES (CPP) AND THE NEW PEOPLE'S ARMY (NPA), OR FOR OTHER 15CRIMES IN PURSUIT OF ONE'S POLITICAL BELIEFS

WHEREAS, it is recognized that certain Filipinos have been arrested, imprisoned, charged 18and/or convicted for acts or omissions punishable under the Revised Penal Code or 19special laws in connection with the rebellion waged by the Communist Party of the 20Philippines (CPP) and the New People's Army (NPA), or for offenses that will otherwise be 21common crimes but were committed or alleged to be committed in furtherance of one's 22political beliefs;

24WHEREAS, Section 19, Article VII of the Constitution expressly vests the power to grant 25amnesty upon the President;

WHEREAS, in order to promote an atmosphere conducive to the attainment of a just, 28comprehensive and enduring peace and as a necessary component and integral part of 29the GRP-NDFP Interim Peace Agreement (IPA), there is a need to declare amnesty in 30favor of the said Filipinos;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODRIGO R. DUTERTE, President of the Philippines, by virtue of 33the powers vested in me by Section 19, Article VII of the Philippine Constitution, do hereby 34DECLARE and PROCLAIM:

SECTION 1. Grant of Amnesty. – Amnesty shall be granted to all Filipinos covered under 37this Proclamation.

SECTION 2. Coverage. - Amnesty shall cover acts or omissions punishable under the 40Revised Penal Code or special laws in connection with the rebellion waged by the 41Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) and the New People's Army (NPA), or for 42offenses that will otherwise be common crimes but were committed or alleged to be 43committed in furtherance of one's political beliefs:

45 Provided, that the crimes for which amnesty shall be granted must have been committed 46 on or before the date of effectivity of this Proclamation; and

48Provided further, that amnesty shall not cover crimes against chastity and rape.

2SECTION 3. Amnesty Grantees. — Any Filipino who is in the list provided by the 3National Democratic Front of the Philippines (NDFP) at the time of the effectivity of this 4Proclamation as a political prisoner, including those on temporary liberty, and who has 5been imprisoned, charged and/or convicted for acts or omissions punishable under the 6Revised Penal Code or special laws in connection with the rebellion waged by the 7Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) and the New People's Army (NPA), or for other 8offenses that will otherwise be common crimes but were committed or alleged to be 9committed in furtherance of one's political beliefs shall be granted general, unconditional 10and omnibus amnesty.

12**SECTION 4.** Application. – Applicants may apply for amnesty under this Proclamation 13with the Department of Justice (DOJ) which is hereby tasked with the function and duty of 14simplifying, receiving and processing such applications and determining whether the 15applicants are covered, in cooperation with the duly authorized representatives of the 16National Democratic Front of the Philippines (NDFP).

18The aforesaid applications must be under oath and must be kept confidential and not 19disclosed without the express written consent of the applicant. Any information contained 20in such applications cannot be used against the applicant for whatever purpose in any 21proceeding.

23**SECTION 5.** Period of Application. – Applications shall be filed with the DOJ after the 24publication of this Proclamation in two (2) newspapers of general circulation. The DOJ 25shall forthwith act on the same with dispatch within a period of seven (7) days from receipt. 26The applicants shall be processed for a period not longer than one week on the humane, 27fair and just presumption that they have been processed repeatedly upon their previous 28arrest, detention and subjection to trial.

30The final decision or determination of the DOJ that is negative to any applicant shall be 31appealable to the Office of the President who shall dispose of the appeal within a period of 32seven (7) days from filing of the appeal.

34SECTION 6. Effects. -

36(a) Amnesty under this proclamation shall extinguish any criminal liability for acts or 37omissions punishable under the Revised Penal Code or special laws in connection with 38the rebellion waged by the Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) and the New 39People's Army (NPA), or for other offenses that will otherwise be common crimes but were 40committed or alleged to be committed in furtherance of one's political beliefs; and

42(b) The grant of amnesty shall also effect the restoration of civil and political rights 43suspended or lost adversely by virtue of any executive, administrative or criminal action or 44proceedings against the grantee.

46**SECTION 7. Effectivity**. – This Proclamation shall immediately be certified as urgent and 47shall take effect upon the concurrence of a majority of all the Members of Congress. Such

1concurrence shall cause to be done within three (3) months therefrom in order to effect the 2expeditious release of the amnesty grantees.
